DENVER REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS HONORS JIM RIESBERG WITH A DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

DENVER – Jim Riesberg received a Distinguished Service Award from the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG). The award was presented by DRCOG board secretary Bob Fifer at DRCOG's annual awards celebration on April 26 at the Sheraton Downtown Denver.
