

What is Colorado's Alternative Transportation Tax Credit?

It's a program that offers a 50% tax credit, up to \$125,000 annually, to organizations that provide alternative transportation options to their employees.

What Qualifies?



Transit Passes

Including RTD EcoPass for unlimited local rides.



Active Transportation Support

Biking or walking subsidies.



Ridesharing Programs

Carpool, Vanpool and Guaranteed Ride Home programs.



E-Bike/E-Scooter Subscriptions

Lime and Bird bikes.



Administrative Expenses

Costs related to managing these programs.

Plan and Develop Your Program

Complete Colorado Department of Revenue Form 1323

Submit Form 1323 via email to DOR_TaxpayerService@state.co.us with the subject line "Alternative Transportation Options Credit".

3

Track Eligible Expenses

Record qualified expenses tied to your alternative transportation program.

4

Claim the Credit

File annually to reclaim 50% of qualifying expenses, up to \$125,000 and \$1000 per employee.
