Resolution No. 11, 2024

A resolution supporting the Regional Transportation District ballot question at the November 5, 2024 election.

Whereas, it is a function and duty of the Denver Regional Council of Governments, as a Regional Planning Commission under the laws of the State of Colorado, to make and adopt an advisory regional plan for the physical development of the territory within its jurisdiction; and

Whereas, the Denver Regional Council of Governments, as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Denver region, is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the continuing, comprehensive and cooperative transportation planning process pursuant to state and federal statutes and regulations; and

Whereas, at the November 5, 2024 election, the Regional Transportation District (District) is seeking the approval of the registered electors of the District regarding whether it shall be authorized to continue to collect, retain and spend all revenues it receives from whatever sources, without regard to the limitations set forth in TABOR; and

Whereas, the DRCOG Board adopted “Metro Vision” regional plan supports a “connected multimodal transportation system to provide everyone with viable travel choices”, including public transit for travel users of various socioeconomic and cultural backgrounds.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that pursuant to its Articles of Association, and the authority granted under Section 30-28-106 of the Colorado Statutes, the Board of Directors of the Denver Regional Council of Governments hereby expresses its support for the RTD 2024 Ballot Question.
