Resolution No. 51, 2024

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with HDR for the Pecos Corridor Study in an amount not to exceed \$440,000 and a term of 14 months from the date of contract execution.

Whereas, this study is part of DRCOG's fiscal year 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program community-based transportation planning set-aside program which focuses on supporting member governments to improve mobility for historically underserved communities; and

Whereas, the Pecos corridor study will look at a 3-mile stretch of Pecos Street between W 84th Avenue and W 62nd Parkway; and

Whereas, DRCOG conducted a competitive bidding process and a selection committee of staff from DRCOG and Adams County determined that HDR had the best proposal; and

Whereas, the selected consultant has demonstrated qualifications developing corridor plans, specifically focused on community engagement and improving multimodal mobility; and

Whereas, DRCOG executed a contract with CDOT in September 2024 to accept \$1.25 million of funds from the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program for the community-based transportation planning set-aside program for federal fiscal years 2024-2025, of which \$450,000 is budgeted for the Pecos Corridor Safety Study.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with HDR for the Pecos Corridor Study in an amount not to exceed \$440,000 and a term of 14 months from the date of contract execution.
