2050 Regional Transportation Plan Update: Regional Roadway System Submissions

Summary

Update on the submissions received through the Call for Revisions for the Regional Roadway System.

Background

For transportation planning purposes, DRCOG designates a Regional Roadway System consisting of freeways (including managed lanes), tollways, major regional arterials, and principal arterials. The system is the planning network DRCOG uses for air quality conformity and greenhouse gas emission reduction analyses and for establishing project eligibility in the Regional Transportation Plan and Transportation Improvement Program.

DRCOG reviews the system at the beginning of each major Regional Transportation Plan update cycle as the basis for developing the plan. In addition to the review and proposed adjustments by DRCOG staff (missing CO state highways, expansion in rural areas), a Call for Revisions soliciting local government revisions was held March 17-April 14 and submissions will be shared at the April meeting.

Basics of the Regional Roadway System

- Currently made up of existing and future freeways, tollways, major regional arterials, and principal arterials.
- Planning network for federal air quality conformity and state greenhouse gas emission reduction analyses.
- Network for eligible capacity projects in the Regional Transportation Plan and Transportation Improvement Program.
- Most heavily traveled & important connecting roadways.
- Targets limited federal funding to the most important roadways in the region.

Actions this update cycle

- Vetting proposed expansion to add roadways classified as Major Collectors and above in rural areas and all Colorado state highways.
- Held a Call for Revisions from March 17 to April 14.
- Presenting at County Transportation Forums on the Regional Roadway System and the proposed expansion.
- Meeting 1:1 with local agencies to answer questions and provide an overview.
