Project Name: 128th Avenue and Riverdale Roundabout and Shared-Use Path

Project Type: Planning + Construction

Project Description:

The proposed project for 128th/Riverdale has the goal of reducing congestion, improving safety conditions, and building infrastructure to encourage alternative modes to motor vehicles. The project work includes the design, environmental review, and construction of intersection improvements at 128th/Riverdale. As part of the design phase, the project team will complete a roundabout evaluation to ensure the planned approach is feasible. This scope of work will also include designing and to building a shared-use path to increase bicycle and pedestrian connectivity to the City's trail network and to Riverdale Regional Park. Public and stakeholder engagement will occur throughout the project, and include both in-person and virtual opportunities for engagement. The County will work closely with the City to ensure that the project is collaborative in nature, and work to address needs from both agencies.

Total Project Cost: \$3.8 million
