Resolution No. 14, 2025

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Fehr & Peers for the Multimodal-Supportive Local Development Standards Toolkit in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 for the period beginning on April 11, 2025 and ending June 15, 2026.

Whereas, the Multimodal-Supportive Local Development Standards Toolkit project is included in the 2024-2025 Unified Planning Work Program; and

Whereas, the Multimodal-Supportive Local Development Standards Toolkit will offer strategies and support for member governments to integrate multimodal elements into new land development projects and redevelopment projects that enhance accessibility, convenience, and connectivity for all travelers; and

Whereas, Denver Regional Council of Governments published a Request for Proposals in January 2025 to solicit proposals from qualified consultants to provide professional services in the creation of a Multimodal-Supportive Local Development Standards Toolkit for the Denver region; and

Whereas, the selection committee made up of staff from DRCOG, CDOT, and local member governments agreed to select Fehr & Peers, based on their extensive experience completing related projects.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Fehr & Peers for the Multimodal-Supportive Local Development Standards Toolkit in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 for the period beginning on April 11, 2025 and ending June 15, 2026.
