Resolution No. 9, 2025

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Building Decarbonization Coalition to design and implement a Contractor Navigation Hub for the building decarbonization program in an amount not to exceed \$4,500,000 through October 16, 2029. The initial contract term will run through April 11, 2027, with the option to renew for additional one-year terms upon satisfactory performance.

Whereas, DRCOG received a \$199.7 million grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Climate Pollution Reduction Grant program to implement a regional building decarbonization initiative; and

Whereas, the program includes a \$4,500,000 budget to design and implement a 'one-stop-shop' that contractors can utilize to simplify the process of installing cold-climate heat pumps for customers; and

Whereas, DRCOG conducted a competitive bidding process administered by a selection panel consisting of subject matter experts from DRCOG's building decarbonization program, the Collective Clean Energy Fund and Xcel Energy staff; and

Whereas, the selection panel determined that the Building Decarbonization Coalition submitted the best overall proposal that demonstrated their experience, capability, understanding and resources to successfully deliver the required services.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Building Decarbonization Coalition to design and implement a Contractor Navigation Hub for the building decarbonization program in an amount not to exceed \$4,500,000 through October 16, 2029. The initial contract term will run through April 11, 2027, with the option to renew for additional one-year terms upon satisfactory performance.
