### Colorado Department of Transportation Transit Connections Study Overview

#### Summary

Staff from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) Division of Transit and Rail (DTR) will provide an overview of the agency's ongoing Transit Connections Study.

#### Background

In working towards building a statewide transit network, CDOT's Division of Transit and Rail (DTR) launched the Transit Connections Study (TCS) in 2024. The TCS aims to provide a strategic vision for an interconnected statewide transit network.

Major components of this study include an assessment of the current state of transit services, a service gaps analysis, and recommendations for service improvements. This includes improving and expanding Bustang services, adding passenger rail services, identifying transit gaps and needs, and fostering connections with intercity regional and local transit/mobility providers.

The TCS will help inform CDOT's transit planning and investment decisions for the next decade, working towards tackling traffic congestion and promoting a more sustainable transportation system, along with fostering strategic growth through accessible multimodal options in Colorado.
